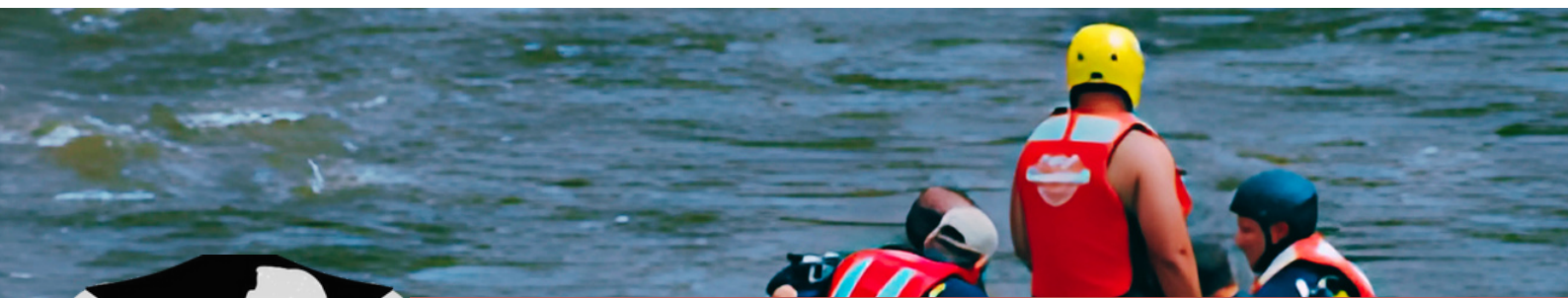

MAKING IT HAPPEN

PREREQUISITES

- At least 18 years of age
- Member of a Public Safety Agency
- RSTC Medical Evaluation
- Proof of Dive Rescue I certification
- A high level of cardiovascular fitness is suggested (13 MET or greater)

BRING TO CLASS

- US Coast Guard approved PFD with knife and whistle
- Adequate clothing and protection from the environment
- Pen and Paper for note-taking and sketching.

Diving students must provide their own equipment:

- Wetsuit or drysuit
- Scuba Regulator: recently serviced and environmentally protected with alternate air source (i.e.: octopus, Air II, etc.)
- Timing Device
- Depth and Submersible Pressure Gauge
- BC with oral/power inflator
- Two tanks with current Hydro and VIP
- Mask, Snorkel, and Fins
- Weight Belt
- Two Cutting Tools (knife, wire cutters, or trauma shears).

TRAVEL

Check with Dive Rescue International to confirm class before making airline reservations.
